TOWNSHIPS OF UGTHORPE AND HUTTON MULGRAVE.

ORDER GROUPING TOWNSHIPS AND CONSTITUTING
PARISH COUNCIL.

To the Chairmen of the Parish Meetings of the townships of Ugthorpe and
Hutton Mulgrave.

To the Parish Meetings for the townships aforesaid.

To the Clerk to the Whitby Rural District Council.

And to all others whom it may concern.


WHEREAS by section 45 (1) of the Local Government Act, 1933, it is provided that the parish meeting of a rural parish may apply to the county council for an order grouping the parish with some neighbouring parish or parishes in the same county under a common parish council and the county council may thereupon make an order accordingly.


AND WHEREAS the Parish Meetings of Ugthorpe and Hutton Mulgrave in the Rural District of Whitby in the Administrative County of the North Riding of Yorkshire have applied to the County Council for an Order under the said section grouping the two townships.

NOW THEREFORE the County Council of the Administrative County of the North Riding of Yorkshire in pursuance of the powers given to it by the Local Government Act, 1933, and of all other powers vested in it, DOTH HEREBY ORDER as follows:—

- (1) the townships of Ugthorpe and Hutton Mulgrave in the Whitby Rural District shall be grouped and the name of the said group shall be Ugthorpe.
- (2) There shall be a Parish Meeting for each of the said townships.
- (3) There shall be constituted a Parish Council for the said group consisting of 6 Parish Councillors of whom 4 shall be elected to represent the township of Ugthorpe and 2 to represent the township of Hutton Mulgrave.
- (4) The first election of Parish Councillors shall be held on such date as the Returning Officer for the Whitby Rural District shall decide, and shall be conducted in accordance with the Parish Council Election Rules, 1949.
- (5) The Parish Councillors elected at such election shall hold office until the ordinary day of retirement of Parish Councillors in the year 1952.
- (6) Any provisions of the Local Government Act, 1894, with respect to the appointment of trustees and to beneficiaries of a parochial charity, and any provisions of the Local Government Act, 1933, with respect to the custody of parish documents shall apply to each of the said townships so as to preserve the separate rights of each township.
- (7) This order shall come into operation on the day of the date hereof, and may be cited as "The North Riding of Yorkshire (Ugthorpe Combined Parish Council) Order, 1949."
